

2015 GOLD BUCKLE FUTURITY AND REINING AUSTRALIA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2015 Reining Australia Gold Buckle Futurity and National Championships Show was held in Tamworth, New South Wales, from Wednesday, 23rd September to Saturday, 26th September. The Australian Equine and Livestock Events Centre accommodated reining enthusiasts from all over Australia with home bases spanning the country from Tasmania to central Queensland. Owners and riders also travelled from our Pacific neighbours to proudly represent New Caledonia and New Zealand in the competition.

More than 150 horses and their human carers and slaves bumped in early in the week to catch up with friends, get the feel of the arena and party a little or a lot until the start of the serious showing. There were more than 340 reining runs over the show and US judges Dean Latimer from Oklahoma and Pat Wickenheiser from California got comfortable in the judges chairs to take in the ride.

The first of many highlights of the show came on Monday evening with the 2015 Hall of Fame Awards ceremony. Reining Australia inducted the influential Quarter Horse stallion Playboy Roy (imp/decd) into the Hall of Fame together with Opal Park Stud and its principals Ian and Judy Waldron for their groundbreaking contributions to reining in Australia.

The serious business of acknowledging the dedicated supporters and promoters of reining in the Hall of Fame was followed by the equally important but less serious business of having fun at a horse show. The Calliope Sliders Reining Horse Club hosted another of their unforgettable theme parties that have become a fixture at the National show. This year, it was a cross-border Tex Mex celebration. AELEC was the scene of strange encounters between people channelling Speedy Gonzalez or the Cisco Kid and ladies dressed to celebrate the Day of the Dead. Rumour has it that next year's theme will be Pirates.

2015 GOLD BUCKLE FUTURITY AND REINING AUSTRALIA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS - WED/THU

After 3 days of open pen and paid warm-ups, the competition proper started on Wednesday with the Reining Australia Green Rider Level 1 & 2 classes. This is entry level reining for Non Pros just starting in the sport. Green Rider is going from strength to strength across the country with more than 50 competitors making the trek to the championships this year, up nearly 50% from numbers in 2014. For some, it was their only run at the show but still they came to Tamworth to be a part of the national community of reining.

Equal 1st in Green Rider Level 1 were Sally Moore on Skip N Acre and Christophe Coulson (New Caledonia) on The Brand Of The Cat with scores of 69.5. Tania Squire on A Little Spinalena won Green Rider Level 2 with a score of 68.5. The winners were rewarded for their efforts with trophy buckles sponsored by Errol & Gita Thomas. It was great to see these riders stepping up on the national stage and showing great enthusiasm in the reining pen.

The Novice Horse Open Level 1 & 2 and Novice Horse Non Pro Level 1 & 2 classes saw 52 runs to start the day on Thursday. Always popular with competitors, the Novice Horse is invaluable as a lead-up event to the bigger classes. There were 4 trophy buckles up for grabs, 2 sponsored by Back On Track, and one each by Pacific Performance Horses and Protecsure Insurance.

All were hotly contested, belying the relaxed ambience of the Novice Horse classes. Winners were Yves Cousinard scoring 143.5 on Spicy Little Step in the Open Level 2, Jason Russell on Flirt N Hug with a score of 140 in the Open Level 1, Brooke Sestero on Jessies Dreamchaser scoring 140.5 in the Non Pro Level 2 and Paul Sharp on PV Treyson scoring 140 in the Non Pro Level 1.

The Prime Time Non Pro class followed after a late lunch break. Entry in this class is restricted to competitors aged 50 years and over but you have to look hard to pick the grey hairs and extra wrinkles as the horses and riders flash past at top speed. A score of 139 by Greg Peters and Chicks Navajo edged out 14 other competitors to win the trophy buckle sponsored by Australian Performance Horse Magazine.

Some of the oldest competitors were followed by the youngest in the next class, the Reining Australia Short Stirrup for riders aged 10 years and under. Saunders Performance Horses sponsored the buckle won by Evie Gilmore riding Hollys Miss Battler.

Next up were the Youth classes, for competitors 13 years and under and 14–18 years, with a total combined draw of 23 horse and rider combinations. No concessions are made to their tender years in judging these riders. Grace Christoffel on Lethal Katie won her class with a score of 135. Reining Australia Youth Ambassador Georgia Mundie and Termite Grounded showed their backs to the older youth with a score of 140.5. Thanks to the trophy buckle sponsors of the Youth classes, Neylon Performance Horses and Thea Griffin and Carol Sergeant.

It was exciting to see the country's future in the reining arena and to get a feel for the sport's potential as reining continues to grow throughout Australia.

The judges enjoyed a short dinner break while the arena was prepared for Thursday's feature events, the Reining Australia Xtreme Genes Open Classic and the Reining Australia Xtreme Genes Non Pro Classic.

The Classic is an aged event for 4, 5 and 6 year old horses and this year was very well supported with 26 Open and Non Pro entries running for buckles and prize money. The Open Classic was won with a score of 149 by Lil Nu It All, a chestnut QH stallion owned by Dennis and Erin Neylon and shown by Warren Backhouse. Winner of the Non Pro Classic with a score of 141 was Checkout Hollywood, a bay QH stallion owned and shown by Kathleen Murphy.

Friday's program started with the Thomas Arena Products Intermediate Non Pro, Intermediate Open and Rookie Professional. These classes ran concurrently with two divisions, the Intermediate Open and Rookie Professional, each going to a runoff to decide the winner. Kim Grosso on DC Caddilac Jack won clear with a 141 in the Intermediate Non Pro class but had to run off against Lana Keldermann on Whizz Fizz for her Intermediate Open buckle. Angela Glover on Hustlin For Chicks and Jason Russell on Flirt N Hug, both on 138, opted to run off for the Rookie Professional buckle with Angela being the eventual victor.

The future of reining looks assured as the Friday program continued after lunch with another megasized class. The Messenger Murray Picello Rookie Level 1 & 2 saw a draw of 40 riders competing for the trophy buckles. Brooke Sestero on Jessies Dreamchaser and Grace Christoffel on Lethal Katie, each with a score of 139.5, were co-champions of both the Rookie Level 1 and Level 2 divisions.

Kim Grosso and DC Cadillac Jack enjoyed great success at the show, winning the champion's buckles in Intermediate Non Pro, Intermediate Open and Limited Open classes.

After the dinner break on Friday, the Rick Meredith Non Pro Futurity and its Intermediate and Limited divisions introduced the evening program. This class featured some show-stopping runs from the big field of 3-year-old reining horses and their Non Pro riders. Every year, participation in the Non Pro Futurity marks a milestone in the lives of some of its competitors. It is their first venture into an arena under the media lights in a feature event that generates national interest. Cameron Halliwell rode a 143 on Gottagetagunner to take the Non Pro Futurity Championship, while Greg Peters on Okies Fancy Step ran a 140 to win the Intermediate and Limited Non Pro Futurity titles.

The Hygain Open rounded off the Friday program. In a fiercely competitive run off with both horses on 144.5, Rob Lawson on Tony Mitchell's imported mare Revolution Reddy outscored Shaun Saunders and QXH Docs Stylish Oak to take home the trophy buckle, trophy and prize money.










- 1. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least 10 feet (3 meters). Hesitate.
- 2. Complete four spins to the right.
- 3. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that the horse is facing the left wall or fence. Hesitate.
- 4. Beginning on the left lead, compete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 5. Complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 6. Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle.

Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.

- 7. Continue back around previous circle but to not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena and past the center marker and do a left rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.
- 8. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence.

Rider may drop bridle to the designated judge.



Pattern 13


Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

- 1. Beginning on the left lead, complete two circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow.
- Stop at the center of the arena
- 2. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
- 3. Beginning on the right lead, complete two circles to the right: the first being large and fast; the second circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena.
- 4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- 5. Beginning on the left lead, run a large fast circle to the left, change leads at the center of the arena, run a large fast circle to the right, and change leads at the center of the arena.
- 6. Continue around previous circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least 20 feet (6meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.
- 7. Continue around previous circle but do not close this circle.

Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.

8. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least 10 feet (3 meters).

Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern. Rider may drop bridle to the designated judge.



To be used for the Youth 10 & Under Short Stirrup class only.

- 1. Beginning, lope straight up the right side of the arena, circle the top of the arena run straight down the opposite or left side of the arena past the center mark and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
- 2. Continue straight up the left side of the arena circle back around the top of the arena run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback-no hesitation.
- 3. Continue up the right side of the arena to the center marker, at the center marker the horse should be on the left lead and complete two circles to the left, one large fast and one small slow. Stop at center.
- 4. Complete three spins to the left. Hesitate.
- 5. Complete two circles to the right, one large fast and one small slow. Stop at center.
- 6. Complete three spins to the right. Hesitate.
- 7. Begin a large circle to the left, do not close the circle.

Continue up the center of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop.

8. Back up at least ten feet. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.
