- Wins in both **Open and Non-Pro divisions**—a rare achievement that speaks to his versatility and temperament

- Contribution to the careers of several accomplished riders, including Kate Mahar,
 Michelle Burnett, and Scott Burnett, helping build both competitive success and coaching pathways
