



# Reining Australia Hall of Fame – horse nomination

## **Purpose**

The Reining Australia Hall of Fame recognises outstanding horses that have made a significant and lasting contribution to the sport of reining in Australia.

## **Eligibility**

- Nominations may be submitted by any current financial member of Reining Australia
- The nominated horse must:
  - Be no longer competing in any reining competition
  - Be at least 15 years of age, or deceased

## **Nomination process**

- Nominations may be submitted at any time to the Hall of Fame Committee
- All nominations will be reviewed annually in June
- The Hall of Fame Committee will assess nominations and provide recommendations to the Board
- Final endorsement of inductees rests with the Reining Australia Board

## **Selection guidance**

In assessing nominations, consideration may be given to:

- The horse's complete competition history within Reining Australia, including National and State titles, records and earnings
- The horse's impact on the sport, including contribution to performance standards and progression of reining in Australia
- The level of recognition, enjoyment and inspiration the horse has provided to competitors, officials and spectators
- Demonstrated longevity, consistency or exceptional achievement at a high level

## **Principles**

- Induction is awarded on merit and contribution to the sport
- The Hall of Fame must not be used to promote bloodlines, ownership interests or for commercial gain
